**A. 201 Frederick Avenue**

The property owner was present and discussed a change in the railing design from iron to an aluminum Trex product. Mr. Rice noted that the Trex product appeared too modern; the iron product fit the time period. Mr. Wildman-Figley stated that Trex offers a more simple/vertical style. Ms. Duff stated that she did not approve of the new railing suggestion based on the historical nature. Ms. Wildman-Figley asked the property owner if they explored a simple, vertical railing in lieu of the curved railing. Ms. Wildman-Figley made a motion to vote on the recommendation of a Certificate of Appropriateness to Council. The motion failed 4-0.
