PUBLIC WORKS REPORT
MARCH 1 – MARCH 31, 2018**

STANDARD ACTIVITY

1. Clean and maintain storm sewer system as required.
2. Maintain parking pay stations/make collections.
3. Maintain/service Police, Public Works and WWTP vehicles.
4. Maintain traffic signals/street lights/road signs/pavement markings.
5. Maintain street lights in business district and on Ohio River Boulevard.
6. Business District – Collected 48 litter cans of trash 8 times.
7. Parks – Collected 24 litter cans of trash 8 times & 2 plastic, glass & aluminum recycling cans 8 times.

CURRENT MONTHLY ACTIVITY

1. Serviced all riding lawn mowers, got all push mowers ready for grass cutting season.
2. Serviced and inspected leaf truck and leaf picker, got it ready for spring clean-up starting April 2 through April 13, 2018.
3. Serviced and inspected street sweeper and did routine maintenance on it.
4. Cleaned Chestnut St. boat launch of debris and mud due to river flooding from heavy rains (river finally went down so we were able to clean boat launch).
5. Repaired or replaced any damaged or old street signs (traffic or street sweeping signs) in town.
6. Repaired broken elevator room door. The door was torn apart by the Fire Department for access controls due to Borough employee being stuck in the elevator.
7. Painted and repaired street closing barricades to get them ready for all our upcoming summer street events.
8. Installed traffic mirrors on Little Street and Duquesne Way. This was a Police recommendation due to an accident.
9. Installed traffic mirror on Nevin Avenue at Crescent Avenue. Residents claim they cannot see cars coming down Nevin Avenue from Crescent Avenue

CURRENT MONTHLY ACTIVITY (CONTINUED)

10. Repaired downspout pipe on Borough Building at the rain garden. The pipe was broken when a vehicle crashed through the rain garden and into the front corner of Borough Building shattering the pipe.
11. Installed “Play at your own risk” signs in every Borough Park and playground. (Signs were installed at the entrances and inside premises.)
12. Repaired gravel walkway at War Memorial Park playground. Gravel washed away due to creek overflowing during heavy rains and flooding. (Placed all new gravel.)
13. Repaired creek bank at War Memorial Park by the YMCA Paddle Tennis Hut. Bank collapsed during heavy rain and flooding. We installed a new section of pipe, dredged creek of debris, placed new rip rap to help hold creek bank and create better water flow. Placed new soil by YMC Hut where it sank and planted new grass to help hold the bank. Recommendation from Franco Verbene is to install gabion baskets along creek banks to reduce erosion on banks and promote better water flow. Also to install new piping especially by the ball field at War Memorial Park.
14. Delivered hanging baskets to Sewickley Green House to get them ready for flowers in preparation for the Garden Club.
15. Assisted in traffic control with Young Brave American 5K and 10K race – set up barricades, road closures and detours.
16. Public Works crew was called out at 1:30 am on March 21 for spring snow storm. Crews worked all day and night to plow and salt nine inches of snow from the Borough Business District and residential streets. Cleared parking spots and plowed snow into piles to be hauled away. Also cleared Borough properties of snow (Borough Building, parks and sidewalks.)
